This Working Group had meetings at MEDICON 2010, in Greece and in EMBEC 2011, in Hungary.

In April 2011 Saide Calil resigned as Chair of this Working Group and the then Vice-Chair, Mario Forjaz Secca, took over as the new Chair. We then appointed as the new Vice-Chair, Kenneth I. Nkuma-Udah.

In July 2011 Mario Forjaz Secca went to Honduras to attend the EHW Summer conference at Tegucigalpa and in August 2011 Kenneth I. Nkuma-Udah and Andre Linnenbank went to Tanzania to attend the EHW Summer conference there. These trips were very important to establish a close working relation with EWH, which is very involved in promoting Biomedical Engineering in the Developing Countries. Mario Secca was Mozambique in August and November 2011 and he started contacts for collaboration with Mozambique.

We started discussions to implement a program of equipment donations or collaborate with international agencies that already work on this.
