- Web submission anytime from 1 October 2015 to 29 February 2016
- Short video presentation plus a summary poster

Scoring:

- Six evaluation criteria will be used to rate and rank the submissions.
- Clinical need, Novelty, Technical merit
- Demonstration of technical feasibility
- Clinical feasibility & translational readiness - IP potential & business model

- Finalist teams will be invited to Hong Kong for the on-site final competition and awa presentations in August 2016.

- Technical Challenge Award(USD1K) (Highest score in the technical merit and demonstration
- of technical feasibility parts in the scoring rubrics)
- Best Presentation Award (USD1K) (Best performance based on on-site presentations)
- Merit certificates (finalists with satisfactory performances based on
- all the 6 criteria in the scoring rubries)
