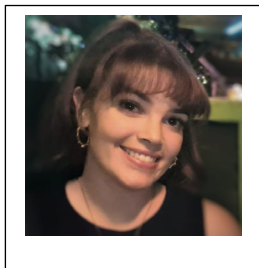
Brief Biography of Nominee (not to exceed 200 words)

My name is Lizzie and I work as a Clinical Scientist in the NHS in the field of Assistive Technology. I originally studied Biomedical Engineering BEng at Aston University, then completed a MSc in Rehabilitation Engineering and Assistive Technology at University College London, where I was awarded Best Postgraduate Research Award at the 2019 Student Symposium for my research project. After this, I went on to complete three years of Clinical Engineering training by doing the NHS Scientist Training Programme (STP), earning another MSc degree in Clinical Sciences (Clinical Engineering). I am now working within the field, assessing patients for complex environmental control equipment and prescribing where appropriate. Outside of work, I do part-time work for the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC) in multiple modalities, marking assessments from international applicants to be admitted to the Clinical Scientist register. I am currently completing a part-time Master's degree in Business Leadership, to develop my skills as a leader. I work as a Recruitment Inclusion Specialist (RIS) for the Trust, partaking in panel interviews for Band 7 and above to ensure that the shortlisting, interview and scoring is carried out in a fair and unbiased manner.

I am constantly looking for ways to give back to the profession that I am so passionate about. Representing IPEM at the IFMBE is perfect for me because I feel strongly about the outreach and promotion of clinical engineering and STEM overall. I have presented at departmental open days and answered questions about my experience on the STP and working within rehabilitation engineering. I have worked with IPEM to lead a virtual discussion for engineering interview techniques and help produce an information pack specific to Clinical Engineering.

I am committed to equality and diversity and have strong personal values, understanding how prejudice can influence care and interactions. I'm particularly excited about their Women In Clinical Engineering (WICE) Project, as helping women in STEM is deeply important to me. I have visited primary schools and spoken to little girls in Year 2, preparing hands-on activities to get them excited about science and interested in STEM. These have been some of the most fulfilling moments in my career thus far. I would hope to contribute more to the IFMBE in this area and continue the excellent work they have started.


